



PRIVATE PAY RATES & ADMISSIONS CRITERIA

Medical Detoxification and Chemical Dependency Treatment for Adults, age 18+

INPATIENT PROGRAM

ACUTE MEDICAL INPATIENT DETOXIFICATION \$700.00 per day
Specialized care for medically compromised individuals with a history of withdrawal or co-occurring disorders that complicate treatment. Provides 24-hour intensive medical/psychiatric and nursing care, continuous observation and behavior stabilization.

MEDICAL REHABILITATION PROGRAM \$650.00 per day
Structured and supportive environment utilizing the 12 Step approach. Offers groups, educational lectures, family education and sessions, experienced clinical staff and daily visits with physician.

VISTA 30 DAY PROGRAM \$600.00 per day
Residential program including patient assessment, group therapy, therapeutic outings, family support systems, and weekly visits with addiction physician as agreed upon.

** Physician fees are excluded from per diem rates.*

INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT PROGRAM (IOP)

\$3500.00, 20 sessions, 6.5 weeks

Three intensive patient focused sessions and one patient/family therapy session a week.

ADMISSIONS CRITERIA

I. Patient age, 18 years and older

II. Primary Diagnosis is treatment of chemical dependency. Coexisting psychiatric condition may be present, but may not be the primary diagnosis

III. One or more of the following signs are exhibited:

- Severe and ongoing use of drugs/alcohol
- Compulsive use of drugs/alcohol
- Continuation of substance use despite negative consequences and a sincere desire to stop.

IV. Inpatient medically supervised detoxification may be required as indicated by any of the following:

- Outpatient detox not possible or dangerous because severity of use.
- Risk of seizure during detoxification
- Symptoms of psychosis, severe agitation, physical aggression, delirium, blackouts, or uncontrolled behavior
- Complication of detox due to a mixture of drugs, a co-occurring psychiatric disorder, or other factors
- Impaired judgment, insight or executive functioning, requiring detox prior to treatment due to substance use

V. Intensity and structure of inpatient treatment is required. Outpatient treatment is likely to fail or be ineffective. Indicators may include:

- Previous failures in outpatient treatment
- Unsafe behaviors posing a risk to self of others
- Impaired insight, judgment or impulse control related to substance use
- Dismissal of negative consequence, severe denial and resistance may be elevated
- Psychiatric instability co-occurring with substance use
- Severe environmental stressor which sabotages treatment or sobriety



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Texas Star Recovery is a hospital licensed program providing substance abuse and co-occurring psychiatric diagnosis treatment.

Inpatient levels of care include:

- Medical Detoxification
- Medical Rehabilitation
- Residential Treatment

Admissions

Direct transfers to the program include a nurse to nurse screening and a medical doctor to medical doctor review for clinical approval.

Criteria

An individual must obtain the ability to:

1. complete activities of daily living skills on an independent level
2. physical ability for group participation
3. independently transfer if use of wheelchair is required
4. safely ambulate

An individual must not obtain:

1. 1:1 staffing requirement
2. persistent psychosis
3. need for outside medical services impacting participation in treatment

Referrals are screened to determine medical and clinical appropriateness. Screening ensures physical and cognitive participation in program is capable.

Texas Star Recovery Program is an approved Medicare and TRICARE provider for psychiatric diagnoses complicated by significant substance abuse problems.
